- What will be your policies and/or procedures when people who are not part of your church walk in and request financial assistance?
- What will be your policies and/or procedures when people in your church need financial assistance?

The Practice of Spiritual Gifts in the Church

The church is to function as a body of believers who are all responsible to practice their spiritual gifts. Please answer the following questions:

- What are the spiritual gifts that should be active today in a biblical church?
- How can you help a person understand what their spiritual gift(s) are?
- What would you do to encourage people who are passively attending church and need to begin participating?

Discipleship in the Church

The main worship service of a church can be a difficult place to get to know others and to use one's own spiritual gifts. Please answer the following questions:

- What is the biblical priority of discipleship in the church?
- In what ways is discipleship being accomplished in your church?
- Are there specific ways that discipleship can be enhanced in your church?
- Describe any discipleship relationships that you currently have.

Good and Bad Shepherds

The Scriptures are replete with information on the contrast between a good shepherd and a bad shepherd.

Provide a list of characteristics of good shepherds versus bad shepherds. Include Scriptural references.

As you consider the characteristics of a good shepherd, what areas would you like to be better developed in your own life?

Missions in the Church

Write a paper as though you were starting a new church and establishing the role that missions will have in your church. Provide a biblical basis and the practical outworking in the life of your church and abroad.

Marriage, Divorce and Remarriage

Marriage, divorce and remarriage will be an issue that you will have to deal with as a pastor. Please answer the following questions and provide a clear biblical explanation:

- Does the Bible permit divorce?
- Does the Bible permit remarriage for a divorced person?
- How would you deal with someone who had an unbiblical divorce and is now remarried?

Practicing Church Discipline

Provide a biblical explanation of church discipline. Matthew 18 is a very important text, but please use other Scriptures as well.

- What sin(s) or types of sin(s) would warrant church discipline?
- When is it better to practice 1 Peter 4:8?

Prayer in the Church

Churches can easily fall into patterns of praying primarily for the physical needs of the congregation. In this paper, please answer the following questions:

- What should be the primary emphasis of biblical prayers?
- How can you encourage people in your church to pray with spiritual priorities?
- How can you improve your own prayer life?
